As a result of pre-arbitration discussions, the parties have mutually agreed to resolve the above referenced case in the following manner:

A violation was established when the grievant was improperly removed from her bid assignment. Management will cease and desist removing part-time regular employees off their bid assignments when no emergency situation exists. An emergency is defined in the JCAM on page 3-1 as "an unforeseen circumstance or a combination of circumstances which calls for immediate action in a situation which is not expected to be of a recurring nature." Unscheduled absences for other employees happen on a daily basis, as evidenced by this case file, so they are of a recurring nature and would not be considered an unforeseen circumstance. Carrier Rodriguez (EIN 04647113) will be paid a lump sum in the amount of \$50 for the violation.
